Addendum for Oregon Residents

Effective Date: October 23, 2025

This Privacy Notice Addendum for Oregon Residents (the "Oregon Privacy Notice") supplements the information contained in the Newfold Digital, Inc. Privacy Notice (the "Privacy Notice"), and applies solely to residents of Oregon ("consumers" or "you"). This Oregon Privacy Notice does not apply to the personal data collected or disclosed by users who manage the data of others while using our Services.

Information We Collect Under Oregon Privacy Laws

We collect personal data, meaning data or any unique identifier, which links to a consumer or to a device. For the purposes of this Oregon Privacy Notice, personal data does not include:

- Publicly available information from government records.
- Deidentified, aggregated or anonymized information that is maintained in a form that is not capable of being associated with or linked to a consumer.

Categories and Examples of Personal Data Collected

We collect this information from you when you attend conferences, visit our websites or establish an account. We use this information to stay in contact with you for business purposes, confirm your identity and authenticate you, and to satisfy regulatory requirements.

Categories of Personal Data Collected	Examples
Personal Identifiers	Name, alias, date of birth, driver's license or Oregon identification card number or passport number.
Contact Information	home, postal or mailing address, home phone number, cell phone number, email address, or other similar identifiers.
Commercial Information	Services purchased and information relating to your use of our Services.
Internet/Network Information	IP address, browser, or device information.

Categories of Personal Data Collected	Examples
Geolocation Data	City of residence, approximate location derived from IP address. Note: We do NOT collect precise geolocation data that identifies your location within a radius of 1,750 feet.
Audio, Electronic, or Visual Information	Phone recordings when you call customer service.
	Information you provide to us when you register for or attend an event organized or hosted by us, information you permit us to see when interacting with us through social media, or comments and opinions you provide to us such as when you post on message boards, blogs or complete an online form.
lidentification and	Certain information such as social security, driver's license, state identification card, or passport number may be collected to confirm your identity or facilitate payment. We will only collect such data when required by law or contract, or confirmation of your identity is necessary to prevent fraud. However, we do not use or disclose the information for any reason except as necessary to perform the Service requested or meet our legal obligations.

We do not collect sensitive data as defined by applicable Oregon law. Specifically:

- We do not collect precise geolocation data within 1,750 feet.
- We do not knowingly collect children's personal data.
- We do not collect data revealing racial/ethnic background, religious beliefs, health diagnoses, sexual orientation, transgender/nonbinary status, victim of crime status, or citizenship/immigration status.
- We do not collect genetic or biometric data.

We do not create profiles about you for the purpose of making decisions that produce legal effects or effects of similar significance concerning you.

Where We Obtain Personal Data

We obtain the categories of personal data listed above from the following sources:

- Directly from you;
- From our business partners and affiliates;
- From third parties whom you direct to share information with us; and
- From your online browsing and usage activity on our websites.

Purposes for Collecting Personal Data

We may collect, use, or disclose personal data about you for one or more of the following businesses and/or commercial purposes:

- To provide the requested Services to you;
- To provide you with useful content;
- To ensure the proper functioning of our Services;
- To offer and improve our Services;
- To provide you with requested information or technical support;
- To facilitate your movement through our websites or your use of our Services;
- To do a better job of advertising and marketing our Services (subject to your consent where required by applicable law);
- To advertise and market third party products and Services (subject to your consent where required by applicable law);
- To diagnose problems with our servers or our Services;
- In connection with our security and compliance programs;
- To administer our websites;
- To communicate with you;
- To target current or prospective customers with our Services through online advertisements served on third-party sites by third-party vendors, such as Google (subject to your consent where required by applicable law); and

 To assist us in offering you a personalized experience or otherwise tailor our Services to you.

Disclosure of Personal Data

TARGETED ADVERTISING AND PROFILING DISCLOSURE

Targeted Advertising:

We DO NOT engage in targeted advertising, which means selecting advertisements for display to you based on personal data obtained from your activities over time and across unaffiliated websites or online applications to predict your preferences or interests.

Profiling:

We DO NOT engage in profiling for the purpose of making decisions that produce legal effects or effects of similar significance concerning you. This means we do not use automated processing of your personal data to evaluate, analyze, or predict factors about you. If our practices change in the future, we will update this notice and provide you with the opportunity to opt out before engaging in such profiling activities.

Sale of Personal Data

When you interact with our websites, we may use, or authorize third-party partners and service providers to use, cookies, web beacons, and similar technologies to improve your experience with us. These technologies can collect personal data about you that can be used by us and/or our authorized third-party partners and service providers. Using your personal data in this way may constitute a "sale" under Oregon privacy laws.

Except as provided above, we do not sell personal data to third parties.

Communicating Personal Data

We do not use personal data for new or secondary purposes beyond the reasons it was collected with your consent or otherwise described in this notice. When our practices change, we will provide you with notice and the opportunity to opt out.

We have disclosed the following categories of personal data for the purpose of showing you ads about products and services offered by the Newfold family:

- Identifiers; and
- · Internet or other similar network activity.

Verifying Your Identity

We will need to verify your identity before processing your request. In order to verify your identity, we will generally require the matching of sufficient information you provide to compare it with information we maintain about you in our systems to authenticate your identity. If you are using an authorized agent, please note that you will be required to verify your identity and provide written confirmation that you have authorized the agent to make a request on your behalf. For requests to access or delete, we may require you to verify your

identity directly with us, and directly confirm with us that you provided the authorized agent permission to submit the request.

Oregon Privacy Rights

As a resident of Oregon you may exercise the following rights with respect to your personal data that we have collected, subject to certain exceptions and after we take reasonable steps to confirm your identity.

- The right to receive an electronic copy of all of your personal data that the we
 collected about you and obtain the copy in a format technically feasible portable
 and commonly used.
- The right to correct inaccuracies in your personal data, considering the nature of the personal data and the controller's purposes of the processing of your personal data.
- The right to delete personal data about you, including personal data you provided to the controller, personal data the controller obtained from another source, and derived data, subject to certain exceptions.
- The right to opt out of the processing of personal data for purposes of targeted
 advertising, the sale of personal data now or in the future, or profiling in furtherance
 of a decision that produces a legal or similarly significant effect concerning a
 consumer. We do not presently engage in targeted advertising nor profiling. To the
 extent our use of cookies constitutes a sale of personal data under the Oregon
 Privacy Act, you have the right to opt out.
- The right to receive a list of specific third parties and persons to which we have disclosed personal data.

Where we process your personal data based on your consent, you may withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of the above rights.

OPT-OUT OPTIONS:

If you'd like to opt out of the sale of personal data or targeted advertising, you have the following options:

- 1. **Cookie Settings:** Go to the site page of your account or brand, and click on the Cookie Settings link in the footer of that page to update your Cookie Settings.
- 2. Universal Opt-Out Mechanism (Effective January 1, 2026): Beginning January 1, 2026, we will honor opt out preference signals sent through browser-based or device-based mechanisms that communicate your choice to opt out of the sale of personal data or targeted advertising. This includes technologies such as Global Privacy Control (GPC). When we detect such a signal from your browser or device:
 - We will treat it as a valid request to opt out.
 - You do not need to take additional action.
 - The opt out will apply to the specific browser or device sending the signal.

Appeals Process:

If you would like to appeal our decision to refuse to act on a privacy right request, you may do so by contacting us through one of the methods above and including your request reference number. We will respond to your appeal within 45 days.

Newfold as a Service Provider

Newfold acts as a service provider to its customers. When acting in this capacity, we process personal data on behalf of our customer, and we have no direct relationship with

the end-users who use our customers' Services or products or visit our customers'

websites.

If you are an end-user of one of our customers whose personal data we process and you

are seeking to exercise your rights under Oregon privacy laws, you should contact our

Data Protection and Security

We maintain reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to

protect the confidentiality, integrity, and accessibility of personal data we collect and
